PCEI Pantry Garden Technician (part-time, Education Award Program)

Education Award Program (EAP) position description:

The volunteer will work with PCEI Watersheds Program staff, AmeriCorps members and volunteers on the care and maintenance of our Pantry Garden.

Responsibilities:

- Assist in care and maintenance of the Pantry Garden: sowing, watering, and weeding.
- Participate in implementation of volunteer events.
- Helps increase participation of community members in the Pantry Garden activities.
- Develop and distribute produce to area food banks.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Committed to serving the needs of the community and the environment.
- Works well independently and as part of a group.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Knowledge of gardening.
- Experience and a willingness to work outdoors.

Schedule:

This position will last a minimum of 4 months (May-August) with a minimum 20 hour work week in order to meet AmeriCorps Education Award Program requirements of 300 hours. Our hours of operation are Monday- Friday 9:00am-5:00pm. Saturday work schedule is also desirable.
